Laurent Cappelletti holds the **CNAM's Accounting and Management Control Chair**. After graduating from *EDHEC*, with a doctorate in management and the ability to conduct research, he began in 1993 as a financial auditor at KPMG, then in 2001 became a lecturer at the *IAE* in Lyon where he directs masters in consulting and in management of liberal activities. At the same time, he is program director at the *Institut de Socio-économie des Entreprises et des Organisations* (ISEOR) and coordinator of the "Tétranormalisation" research network, for which he directs the collective work "Normes : origines et conséquences des crises" published in 2010 by Economica. Since 1998, he has produced more than a hundred publications on management control, internal control and human capital, which have received two "awards"

from the Academy of Management (USA), in 2005 in Hawaii and in 2009 in Chicago.
